### **Professional Profile**

I have been involved in Health and Safety for 6 years and have been involved in construction/ Engineering for nearly twenty years. I am currently working as Health and Safety advisor for the principal contractor at TBPP, Interserve and have been employed for 18 months after being employed on the project by a sub-contractor, Blocotelha.

I was the UK Health and Safety for a Blocotelha overseeing three new build biomass/EFW projects in Templeborough, Margam and Dunbar.

It was a challenging job at times to change the attitudes and behaviour of some of the management and they didn't have any safe systems of work in place or documentation when I arrived. I feel they benefited from my input and personal experiences and I have also benefited from working with them.

Prior to this I was a EHS representative for CB&I at Carrington CCGT for eighteen months.

I carried out inspections covering the Point of Work Risk Assessments and daily audits, involved with CB&I's Behavioural System (ICare). I attended weekly meetings with the main contractors and also with the client as EHS representative to discuss ongoing site issues and a plan of action to resolve these. Also compiled Accident/incident investigation reports to the client.

I was a voluntary member of the Emergency Response Team at Carrington CCGT and participated in associated training and exercises which I enjoyed greatly.

My first Safety role was at the Runcorn TPS project for Interserve Industrial services.

I provided support for EHS team's. My responsibilities include, developing and reviewing Method Statements and Risk Assessments, attending weekly Client Health and Safety meetings and also company Health and Safety meetings, job safety analysis and root cause analysis, training for operatives.

As a Health and Safety advisor I have gained excellent communication skills working with multi-lingual work forces and I am able to liaise with small or large groups on site. I am proactive in my approach to Health and Safety and will not shy away from difficult situations, such as high risk activities, including working at height, confined space safety, hot works, plant vehicle operation and commissioning activities.
